Body Double 13 (1999) – 3min 20sec, starring Brice Dellsperger. Sequence after John Badham's 'Saturday Night Fever'

Dellsperger plays both roles himself as he humorously recreates the couple's dance floor spin.

Body Double 16 (2003) – 6min 24sec, starring Jean-Luc Verna. Sequence after Stanley Kubrick's 'A Clockwork Orange' and Ken Russell's 'Women in Love' Brice Dellsperger's most recent work, his first remake to be done in two parts, is notably based on two British films. The recreation of a lesser-known scene from Kubrick's cult classic is juxtaposed with the famous naked wrestling scene from Russell's film, which, like 'A Clockwork Orange', was banned in England for its 'obscene' content. The video features artist Jean-Luc Verna, who also starred in Dellsperger's cult full-length remake,



'Body Double X', based on Andrzej Zulawaski's film 'L'Important C'est d'Aimer' ('The Important Thing is to Love'). "Mr.Verna should get an Oscar in a category of Mr. Dellsperger's devising; the acceptance speech could continue their brilliant collaboration" (Roberta Smith, New York Times, 8 March 2002).

Body Double 17 (2001) – 16min 27sec, starring Gwen Roch and Morgane Rousseau. Sequence after David Lynch's 'Twin Peaks: Fire Walk With Me' Delisperger uses sisters to play all of the roles in this remake of the roadhouse scene from 'Fire Walk With Me'. Though not twins, the sisters look so alike that it becomes increasingly difficult to tell them apart.
